The LANC Fund is an endowed fund within the NCBA Foundation Endowment for the benefit of Legal Aid of North Carolina. Your contribution will help build the long-term financial stability of LANC. Our Endowment is a professionally-managed endowment of almost \$6 million that will safeguard these funds.

The NCBA Strategic Plan *Momentum 2010* challenges us to raise our level of support for legal services to the national average. Bar groups nationwide (other than IOLTA organizations) contribute approximately \$1.60 per indigent individual to legal services programs each year. North Carolina's legal community contributes only \$0.25 per individual.

The LANC Fund initial goal of \$100,000 will activate the fund. In each future year, LANC will receive an annual five percent grant from this endowed fund. Other types of gifts (planned gifts, cy pres funds, etc.) will also grow the fund over future decades into a viable revenue stream for LANC and support its important efforts to meet the civil legal needs of poor people in North Carolina.
